You can get the mid-size one and small one as well.)***Pencils***Wood pencils are fine. If you use them make sure to have an x-acto knife and sandpaper block in order to sharpen them appropriately, if you choose to use wood pencils purchase at least 2 - h pencils.**I use the pencils listed below which are very convenient and efficient.
