MATERIALS FOR STUDENT PAINTING:

Paint

Utrecht makes a very affordable high quality paint and is available at Dick Blick.

Titanium White Oil Paint (38 ml)

Raw Umber Oil Paint (38 ml)

Brushes

Bristle brushes (Filberts and/or Rounds [sizes #2 to #10])

A Sable Brush or synthetic Sable Brush (size #1)

Wooden Palette, Oval 9X12

Wood Stretcher Bars

2 Standard Stretcher Bars 8"

2 Standard Stretcher Bars 10"

Turpenoid

Small Palette Knife

Single Palette Cup

Empty Aluminum Paint Tube 2 oz.

Blick Unprimed Cotton Canvas

(Medium or Medium Smooth) (60" x 1 yd)

MATERIALS FOR STUDENT DRAWING:

Soft Charcoal, pkg of 5B

(Nitram Adademie Fusains Charcoal is recommended)

Medium Charcoal, pkg of 5HB

(Nitram Adademie Fusains Charcoal is recommended)

Sharpener

Sandpaper Block

(under a dollar at Dick Blick)

Kneaded Eraser

Accurasee Proportional Divider

(optional)

Charcoal Paper

(either pad or individual sheets)

Instructor will go over materials in class, information about buying brushes, and will show students how to stretch their own canvases. He will also show students how to make their own maul stick, and brush cleaner cans.

RECOMMENDED PURCHASE LOCATION

Before first class meeting: Blick Art Materials, South Mall, Allentown

These are recommended supplies. Instructor is willing to work with whatever materials a student wishes to work with. Students do not need paint medium for the first class and will be based on whether the student is Alla Prima or glazing.
