Thank you for your interest in the *Disability Pride Lehigh Valley Juried Exhibition*! This exhibition is in collaboration with Disability Pride Pennsylvania and the Lehigh Valley Arts & Cultural Alliance. It will be on display during the 2024 Disability Pride Lehigh Valley on July 20, 2024 next to The Baum School in the Allentown Arts Park.

ARTIST REQUIREMENTS

- The artist must identify as a person with a disability. Disability is a broad umbrella that covers a variety of lived experiences. Eligible artists may have visible, physical, and/or sensory conditions as well as less visible conditions like anxiety, ADHD, depression, chronic illness/pain, PTSD, OCD, dyslexia, dysgraphia, neurodivergence, and more
- There is no fee to apply.
- Visual artists working in 2D and 3D mediums are invited to apply. May include (but not limited to) drawing, painting, video/digital, photography, metal, ceramics, paper, plaster, and found objects.
- 2D Work
 - o Framed with all necessary hanging mechanisms or matted without a frame.
 - o Maximum dimensions: 36" x 36"
- 3D Work
 - o Maximum dimensions: 15" x 15" x 15"

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Submit up to 2 works. Works must be submitted through the Google Form: https://forms.gle/Xffzs2LCPJxKEeai7
- 2. Please include images of each artwork as well as Title, Medium, Size, and Price or Value if Not for Sale.
- 3. Include a brief artist statement describing your work (for example, your inspiration or creative process)
- 4. All submissions must be received by **Friday June 7, 2024**. Application reviews will commence shortly thereafter, and applicants will be notified in mid-June.

Artists are invited to sell their work. All sales will be split 70% to the artist and 30% The Baum School of Art.
